## <u>Page 80:</u> "ALEXANDRIAN MACEDONIAN" Additional information:

- > A battlegroup of 12 heavy foot bases paid for as 2 x 6-base medium foot BGs counts as 2 BGs for deployment purposes. (Both BGs of 6 must be adjacent in the order of march and the 12-base BG must be deployed at the time that the first BG of 6 would be placed).
- > The army size is recalculated after deployment.

Page 86: TABLE "WARRING STATES TO WESTERN HAN" Territory - ADD "Others - Agricultural, Developed, Hilly"

<u>Page 112:</u> TABLE "LATER CARTHAGINIAN" - Balearic slingers - REPLACE "Protected" with "Unprotected"

<u>Page 116:</u> TABLE "ATTALID PERGAMENE ALLIES" - CinC - DELETE "Inspired Commander" and REPLACE points per base "80/40/30" with "30/20"

<u>Page 119:</u> "PARTHIAN AND EARLY SASSANID PERSIAN" INSERT an additional bullet under "Building a customised list using our army points"

• From 100BC to 224 AD Parthians (not Suren Indo-Parthian) may convert one BG of 4 Average Cataphracts to:

Cataphract Camels: Camelry, Heavily Armoured, Average, Undrilled, Lancers/swordsmen at 16pts per base.

<u>Page 123:</u> TABLE "ANCIENT SPANISH (CONTINUED)" - Special Campaigns - Roman Legionaries: REPLACE "Protected" with "Armoured"

Page 129: TABLE "LATER JEWISH ALLIES" - Upgraded Thureophoroi - protected: REPLACE "0-16" with "0-12"

Page 140: TABLE "ANCIENT BRITISH AND CALEDONIAN" Allied Commanders: CHANGE "1-3" to "\*1-3"
